

Module 15: Sentence Completions

Sentence completions allow students to practice with new words by bringing their own contexts to the words.

- The teacher gives an open-ended sentence and students finish it
- Each prompt contains the vocabulary word, but leaves the sentence ending open
- The beginning of the sentence is generic enough so that student can use their own context to supply the ending
- Write the prompts in the first person, so students can connect the context to their own experiences
- Prompts should be related to topics or experiences familiar to students
- Students respond in writing, then share and discuss their responses
